

Règlement Interclubs Juniors

1. Organization:

The event called “62th Tour du Condroz” is organized by UC SERAING according to the UCI and Belgian Cycling regulations. It takes place on Monday May 25, starting at 1.30 p.m.

2. Type of event:

The event is reserved for athletes in the Junior category. It is included in the national calendar Belgian Cycling in class JUN 1.14 IC and counts for the LOTTO-Belgian Junior Cup.

3. Participation: The event is reserved for the 24 teams selected by the RLBV road commission.

1 team can still participate in off-road events until the maximum number of 25 teams is reached:

- A regional team (an FCWB or Cycling Vlaanderen selection) or a Belgian provincial team, provided that it submits its application no later than three months before the date of the organization with a copy to Belgian Cycling, Secretariat Commission Route, Rue de Bruxelles 482 at 1480 Tubize. A regional or provincial team must be made up of runners from at least 2 clubs with a RPC recognition that do not participate in the Belgian Lotto-Cup, including in the selection a maximum of 50% of riders from the same club.

The teams will be composed of 6 runners maximum or 4 runners minimum..

4. Permanence:

- All departure formalities will be done at Hall Omnisports rue du Moulin 11b à 4180.
- Confirmation of starters and collection of bibs by team managers is done at the open from 10.30 a.m. to 11:15 a.m.
- The Sports Directors meeting will take place at 11:30 a.m.
- Signing of the start sheet and the presentation of the teams on the podium will begin at 12:15 a.m. and end at 1:15 p.m.
- The arrival desk will be held at the same location.

5. Registration procedure:

At least 20 days before the event, the team sends the names of the sports director, riders and reserves in the online registration module (comp.kbwb-rlvb.com). The team and the organizer receive a confirmation by email.

72 hours before the start time of the event, the team sends the names of the starters and two replacements in the online registration module.

At the latest 15 minutes before the meeting of sports directors, the team sports director must confirm to the College of Commissaires the identity of the participating riders.

6. Radio-tour:

Race information is broadcast on frequency 160.10625 channel 2.

7. Voitures techniques :

- Chaque équipe a le droit de mettre un véhicule de soutien dans la course. L'ordre de Les voitures seront établies par tirage au sort pendant la séance d'information, conformément aux règlements de l'UCI.
- A l'arrivée, les voitures des directeurs sportifs et autres (à l'exception des véhicules des membres du jury de commissaires) sont tenus d'utiliser la déviation mise en place par l'organisateur.
- Un laissez-passer sera également délivré aux véhicules d'aide aux aidants naturels
- Le service d'assistance technique neutre est assuré par deux voitures neutres et une moto.

8. Medical assistance:

two ambulances and a doctor will follow the race.

9. Refuelling:

Refuelling will be permitted from technical cars after 30 km up to 20 km before arrival and in accordance with the rules set out in articles 2.3.026 and 2.3.027 of the UCI regulation.

- Waste collection and refuelling areas at km 38,8 - 51,9 - 92,8 - 105,7
- Waste collection zone km 39,1 - 93,1

10. Deadlines:

- Any rider arriving within a time limit exceeding 8% of the winner's time is no longer retained for the general general classification. The deadline may be increased in exceptional circumstances by the College commissioners, in consultation with the Organizer
- Elimination times in the race are set at five minutes behind the main peloton. Runners, and especially late runners, are reminded that the highway code must be respected.

11. Rankings:

- Individual ranking of the event.
- The inter-club ranking is based on the addition of the three best individual times of each team. In case of a tie, the teams are divided by the addition of the places obtained by their top 3 runners. In case of a new tie, the teams will be divided by the place of their best rider.
- The ranking of the G.P.M. Mountain will be established by adding the points awarded on all 8 listed coasts. The first three riders will receive 5, 3 and 1 points respectively. In case of a tie, the finish will be taken into account. To be eligible for the GPM prize, competitors must complete the event on time.

12. Prizes:

- The prizes will be paid to the Office directly after the rankings have been established.

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13. Anti-doping:

- The anti-doping regulations of the UCI, BelgianCycling and the French Community apply in accordance with the provisions of Belgian law.
- The anti-doping control will take place at la Maison des Association route de Tohogne 14 à 4180 Hamoir.

14. Protocol:

The first three classified runners at the finish and the first three classified runners in the classification the Mountain are required to appear at the protocol ceremony which will be held at the height of the finishing line.

15. Environment:

Trash cans will be placed in the departure zone, in the arrival zone as well as in the cloakrooms. We ask that you respect the environment by telling your runners to avoid throwing packaging and cans into nature and to respect the areas of refueling, as well as waste areas set up by the Organizer.

16. Penalties:

The BelgianCycling penalty scale is the only one applicable. All cases not provided for herein regulations will be decided by the College of Commissioners in accordance with the provisions in use at the UCI or BelgianCycling.
